

Parade Information and Instructions

June 11, 2017 Line Up: 1:30pm EST Parade: 3:00pm EST

Entering the Parade

- A. The deadline for entering the Three Oaks Flag Day Parade is May 31, 2017. Entry forms may be mailed, e-mailed, or delivered in person by the end of this day.
- B. In order for our announcers to have complete information of your entry, we ask for a written or e-mailed description of your unit. Please include: printed names of people in your unit, the length of your unit, and any pieces of history relating to your unit or hometown are always a welcomed.
- C. The Flag Day Committee reserves the right to reject any unit that is not in good taste, inappropriate, or not in the best interest of the Parade.
- D. All parade applications need to have an e-mail address, as well as a phone contact. Please note: Line-up and street location will be e-mailed to you the week before the parade.
- E. All entries must present the American Flag on the unit.

Pulling Vehicles

- A. Each unit shall provide their own pull vehicle.
- B. Vehicles may be a Car, Pick-up truck, or tractor
- C. Extra vehicles need to be indicated on the application so that space is allowed in lineup
- D. Each Float and pulling vehicle must have a fire extinguisher.

Conduct During the Parade

- A. We ask that nothing be dispersed from moving vehicles.
- B. Walkers are allowed to hand out candy, but care should be taken to keep candy out of the path of other units.
- C. Once you have passed the starting point of the parade please maintain 50 feet spacing interval between units.
- D. If your unit will stop and perform during the parade route, it must be indicated on your entry form.
- E. Equine and other animals units must provide their own accompanying cleanup personnel with shovels, rakes, and containers.
- F. Politian's and Elected officials must stay in a vehicle and may only have two walkers with them. Please do not hand out campaign material during the parade.
- G. It is strongly recommended that all parade participants bring bottled water, as the weather can be warm, especially when standing in parade costume.
